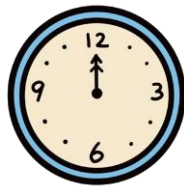

home that he/she also brings the necessary items in order to reheat and eat their meal. Thank you for your consideration.

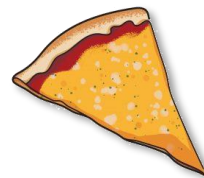
